
When re-keying or installing lock, be sure to engage the plastic lever locking insert.

INTERCHANGEABLE CORE HOW TO REMOVE CORE




Inseret control key and turn 15 degrees to the right until action stops. Pull on key to extract core.

HOW TO REPLACE CORE




CORE TAIL PIECE AND TAIL PIECE COVER APPLICATION




For function only use tail piece & tail piece cover. pushing "A" point, spin tall piece cover on the right as above picture.

DISASSEMBLE INTERCHANGEABLE LEVER



The outside Lever can be disassembled by pulling the outside Lever with pushing the Lever catch by driver through the hole on the outside Lever.


INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLING HEAVY DUTY LEVER LOCK



THIS LOCK IS FACTORY-PACKED FOR 13/4" THICK DOORS.


1. MARK DOOR

I TO THE PERSON NAMED IN



Mark height line on edge and face of door. Detach stub of template and mark center of door thickness on heightline. Fold template at proper marking for bevel of door(high or low bevel or flat). Position center line of template on height line. Hold in place and mark center point for 21/g "hole. And then the 1"or7/g"hole. Also mark for 5/16"holes for mounting screws.

2. BORE HOLES




Bore a 21/8° hole and %6° holes. Bore holes from both sides of door to avoid splintering wood.

NOTE: We recommend using a drill guide to ensure straight holes. Bore a 1"or 7/8"hole straight into door edge to intersect with center of 21/8" hole. Use latchfront faceplate to pattern for curout. Front should fit flush with door edge. Install latch with screws provided.

(Wood door applications)
For proper alignment of lock chassis and lever,
cut out notches for anchor plate lugs from both
sides of door on horizontal height line.
Mortise for anchor plates on both sides
of door(see template).


NOTE: Width of notches should not exceed 1/8 for snug fit of anchors.



() LOCK BODY

- To remove inside lever (3). Insert push tool (provided) into hole on lever to depress the lever catch. Slide the lever from the tube. Remove inside rose (4) by slightly twisting counter-clockwise and pulling off.
- 2. Unscrew two#10-32UNFx15/eL (5) screw and remove rose insert (6).

4. INSTALL OUTSIDE UNIT




The lock body must engage the latch unit prongs as shown. The lock body retractor must engage the latch unit tail piece. Door must be open when installing lockset with guarded latch unit.

NOTE:

- Be sure latch unit tail piece is centered about lock body retractor. Adjust it if necessary by outside plate.
- For lock with outside securing stud type, slide two outside securing stud into prepared holes on door.

CAUTION:


DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MOUNT LOCK UNIT WITH DOOR CLOSED.




NOTE:

USE WHITE LONGER SCREWS FOR DOOR THICKER 'THAN 1-5/8".

- Position the screw holes vertically with winder notch at inside diameter in line with lever catch. Then slide onto tube and align rose screw holes with#10-32UNFx 15/6"L screw 5. (See note)
- 2. Place inside rose (4) onto inside rose insert (5) aligning two lances with recesses in rose insert (6) and turn clockwise to lock as firmly as possible
- Slide inside lever 3 onto tube. Make certain lever catch on tube is engaged with lever.



When strike box is not used, recess in door jamp must be deep enough to allow latch bolt to extend to its full free length.





Deadlocking plunger on latchbolt stops against strike, preventing forcing when door is closed.

7. ADJUST FOR DOOR THICKNESS

Disassemble the outside Lever (fig.2 or fig.3) and take off the outside Rose assembly.


Adjust the door thickness by turnning the out side plate with hand.






8. REMOVE OUTSIDE LEVER

A STATE OF THE STA



Keyed locks:
Insert key into cylinder and using pointed end of spanner wrench, or similar tool, place into hole in lever.
Turn key approximately 1/2 turn while exerting pressure on wrench until lever catch depresses. Pull off lever and driver.



Non-keyed locks: Place pointed end of spanner wrench, or similar tool, into hole in lever, Push in to depress lever catch and remove lever and driver.
